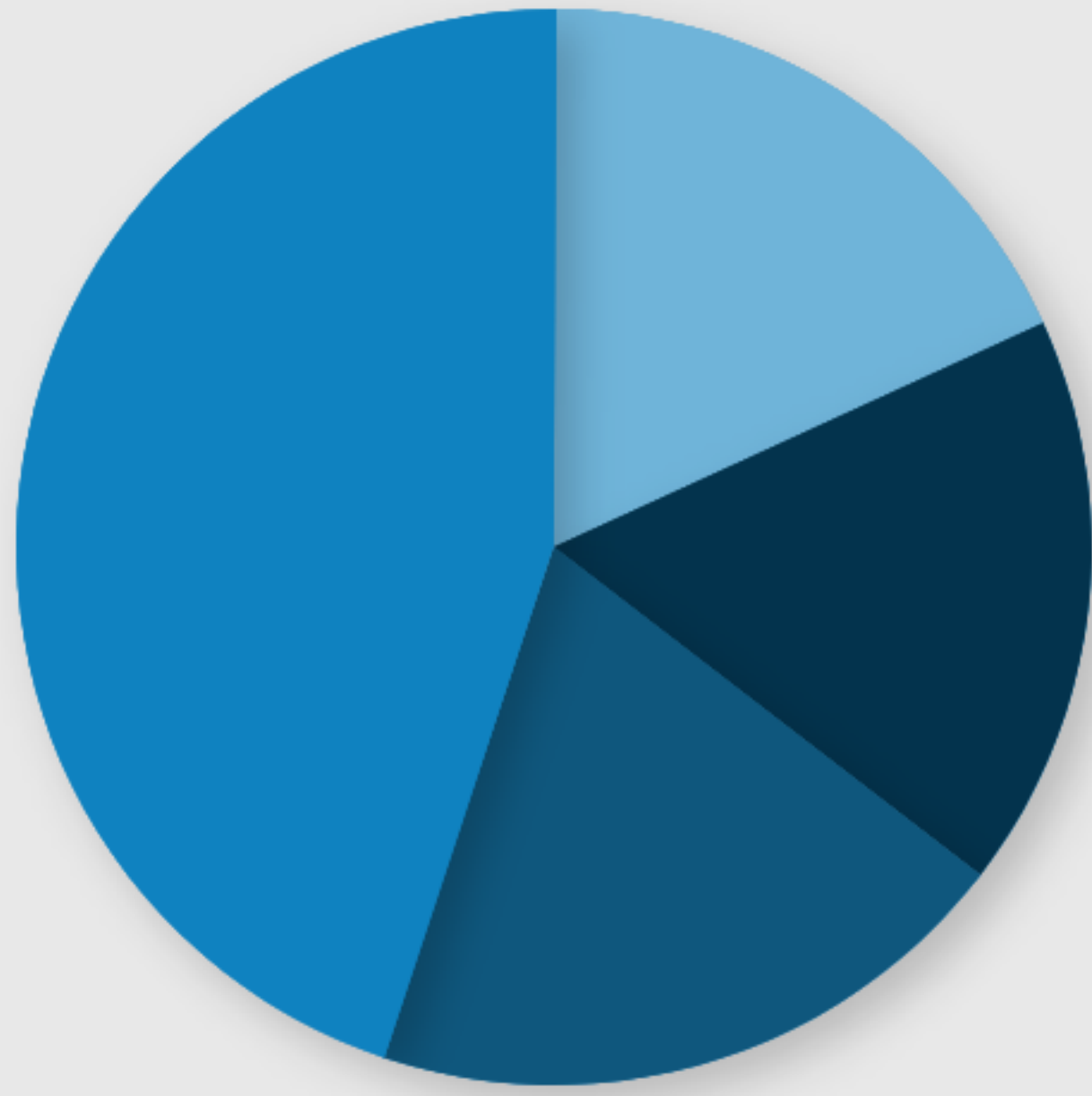
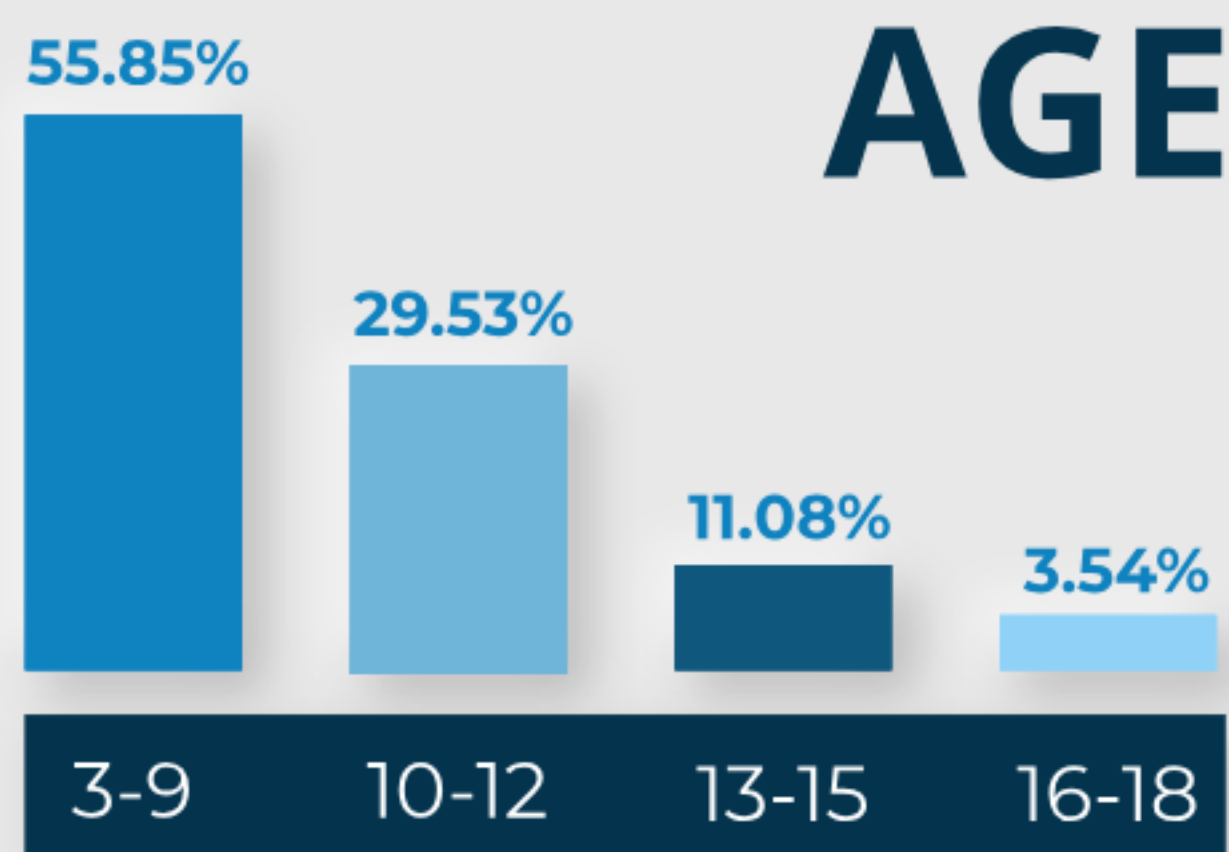

## CHARTER SCHOOLS

We are one of two Boys & Girls Clubs affiliates in the United States that operates charter schools. Our campuses are located in San Marcos, TX and Austin, TX.

Through partnerships with our parents, our teachers and our community partnerships, we create a learning environment that improve student achievement.

## PRE-KINDERGARTEN

Our tuition based Pre-K programs are full day, year round and available for ages three to five years old.

## AFTER SCHOOL & SUMMER PROGRAMS

Our teens are served through the Character & Education Programs known as Torch Club and Keystone Club.
